The job holder is responsible for the general maintenance of the compounds, gardens, plants and lawns at the School to ensure they are well-cleared, maintained, and neat at all times. The role also requires Strong leadership and people management skills, with a thorough understanding of grounds maintenance techniques, safety regulations, and environmental sustainability practices.

The Head Grounds man reports to the Executive Assistant.

Key Responsibilities:

- 1. Lead and supervise the grounds keeping and maintenance team.
- 2. Develop and implement a grounds maintenance plan, including regular inspections and maintenance schedules.
- 3. Oversee the landscaping and gardening activities, including planting, weeding, pruning, and lawn care.
- 4. Maintain sports fields, playgrounds, pathways, and outdoor recreational areas to ensure safety and accessibility.
